Minneapolis, Minnesota - The University of Minnesota Men's Lacrosse Team is pleased to present the Chris Jenkins Invitational February 23-25th 2007. Participating teams are the #10 Lindenwood University Lions, and #11 California Polytechnic State University Mustangs, #12 University of Minnesota Duluth Bulldogs, and the host Minnesota Golden Gophers. Games will be held at Rod Wallace Field in the Gibson-Nagurski Football Complex, 600 15th Ave., on the University of Minnesota's east bank campus. Admission will benefit the Andy Boyles and Chris Jenkins Memorial Funds. A 5-game pass is \$5 for adults, \$3 for students, and free for children under 13.

The Andy Boyles Memorial Lacrosse Clinic sponsored by North Star Lacrosse will be held between Saturdays' invitational games. The clinic is open to boys in grades 9-12. The clinic will be staffed by former college players from programs such as Maryland, Notre Dame, Whittier, Clarkson, and Adelphi; MCLA All Americans, as well as coaches and players participating in the Chris Jenkins Invitational. The clinic will feature game speed drills, strategy tips, individual coaching on specific techniques, contests and more. All Clinic participants receive free admission to the Invitational. A waiver signed by the parent of each participant must be presented at registration. Chris Jenkins was an All America goalie and 3-time Captain of University of Minnesota Golden Gopher Lacrosse team who went missing his senior year in October of 2002. Chris' body was recovered from the Mississippi River in February of 2003. Although a homicide investigation was opened in late 2006, the circumstances surrounding Chris' death are yet to be fully resolved.

Andy Boyles was the manager of the Roseville Area High School Lacrosse team who died of muscular dystrophy in August 2000. Andy's family initiated the idea for a clinic that would honor his love for the game, and build the visibility and skill level of high school lacrosse players in the Twin Cities metro area.
